Southwestern High School

The primary mission of the Community Foundation of Madison and Jefferson County, Inc. is to assist donors to build an enduring source of charitable assets to benefit the Jefferson County community. Many donors have sought to achieve this goal by endowing gifts for scholarships for higher education so that people like you will have a greater likelihood of reaching their potential.

Attached please find a list of scholarships currently available in the Community Foundation that Southwestern High School seniors are eligible for.

- Unless otherwise noted, the scholarship application deadline is noon March 7, 2011.
- These awards are generally for tuition only. Therefore, students already receiving a full-tuition award from a college or another source are not eligible for Community Foundation scholarships.
- These scholarships are not renewable unless otherwise noted.
- Employees and board members of the Community Foundation, as well as family members of the aforementioned individuals, are ineligible for competitive Community Foundation scholarships. This includes spouses, lineal descendants and their spouses, and brothers and sisters and their spouses. The period of ineligibility extends through the calendar year following the year in which the volunteer position or employment ends.
- Family members of selection advisory committees are ineligible for Community Foundation scholarships. This includes spouses, lineal descendants and their spouses, and brothers and sisters and their spouses.

Jefferson County 4-H Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Graduating seniors or recent graduates from any Jefferson County high school who have completed four years of regular 4-H. Intended to help students finance post high school educational programs at vocational schools, colleges, etc. Criteria evaluated: 4-H participation. Apply through the Jefferson County Extension Office.

Ernie Brierly Memorial Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Southwestern High School graduating seniors who played on the girls' softball or basketball teams. The criterion evaluated is the need for financial assistance to continue their education.

Broadway School Alumni Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Graduating Jefferson County high school seniors. Criteria evaluated: financial need, demonstrated academic ability, and demonstrated concern for school and community. Required: 200 word essay on the role the Broadway High School (that was located in the 600 block of Broadway, the first commissioned colored high school in the state of Indiana) played in the history of Madison.

Keith Brooks Memorial Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Southwestern High School graduating seniors who in their senior year played on the high school boy's varsity basketball team. For furtherance of post-high school education including, but not limited to college, junior college, university or trade school. Qualified applicants shall have maintained a high school grade point average of 2.0 or above. In the event of a tie, the tie-breaker will be financial need.

Madison Chautauqua Scholarship For the Arts

Eligible Applicants: Jefferson County, Indiana high school juniors, seniors, and adult residents who wish to further their education in the visual or performing arts. May be used for tuition to attend a college, vocational school, IRS qualified summer study or short courses not leading to an academic degree. All art forms are eligible, including the visual and performing arts and photography. Required: Letter of recommendation from a person knowledgeable about your talent and accomplishments in your art form, along with a sample of your work in the form of slides, cassette, CD, or videotape, with a maximum of 3 slides and one 3-minute tape or CD. Note: This scholarship has its own application and may be picked up at your counselor's office.

Lisa Cheatham Memorial Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: A Southwestern High School graduating senior who attended this school for at least three years and who has a GPA of at least 2.5. A good person who has contributed to the esprit de corps of the school. Financial need is a factor only if a potential tie exists. The award is for tuition at any accredited post-high school educational institution.

Christie Crafton Memorial Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Graduating seniors from Southwestern High School, New Washington High School, and Scottsburg High School who wishes to pursue a four-year degree at an Indiana college or university in primary or secondary education or related profession that serves children at an Indiana college or university. Special consideration will be given to those who wish to become elementary school teachers. Financial need shall be a tie-breaker.

Ralph & Robyn Jones Family Memorial Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Jefferson County high school graduating seniors with a GPA of less than 3.7 and a family adjusted gross income of \$30,000 to \$50,000 per year. Those with higher incomes may be considered if extraordinary financial need can be demonstrated.

Dale McNeely Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: are graduating seniors from Southwestern Jefferson County Consolidated High School who have demonstrated financial need and who have demonstrated moral character, community service, scholarship, and church attendance.

Marcia S. Morrill Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Southwestern High School graduating seniors. Students must apply using the Rotary Club's scholarship application, following its instructions. Preference will be given to students who intend to enter the field of education or a field related to education and based on character and school/community involvement and must exemplify Rotary Founder, Paul Harris' motto, "He profits most, who serves best".

J. Michael Sample Memorial Scholarship for Music

Eligible Applicants: Graduating Southwestern High School senior who is an outstanding music student, either vocal or instrumental, with plans to attend a four-year accredited college or university.

Brian W. Stites Memorial Scholarship

Eligible Applicants: Graduating Southwestern High School seniors who during their senior year played on the Southwestern men's varsity baseball team. May be used for post-high school education, including but not limited to college, junior college, university, or trade school. Qualified applicants shall have maintained a high school grade point average of 2.0 or above. In the event of a tie, the tie-breaker will be financial need.
