



2012 Grant Awards

Girls Inc. of Jefferson County - \$500 to implement the *Girls Inc. Economic Literacy* Program to teach girls about basic economic concepts like earning, saving, spending, and sharing money

Jefferson County Transitional Services , Inc. - \$1,250 to purchase new curriculum to promote mental health well being for the residents of Ruth Haven

LifeSpring Health Systems - \$3,360 to provide an 8-week parenting class to residents of Jefferson County

Madison Consolidated Schools AVID Program - \$4,940 to implement the AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) Program for Madison Jr. High 7th and 8th grade students
